ADP offers Virtual Private Network (VPN) Access for those vendors who require network access to ADP dealers. VPN Access provides vendors, with dealer approval, reliable, point-to-point network connectivity to the ADP Dealer Management System (DMS).

VPN Access is one of the Subscriber Access solutions that ADP offers as part of its comprehensive Third Party Access Program. VPN Access leverages ADP's nationwide network to allow vendors to reach dealers without having to build and manage network connectivity themselves.

Network Access for Vendors; Security for Dealers

ADP's VPN Access solution features:

- Provides third party a method to access a DMS at the user logon prompt level over the ADP support network instead of dialing in via modem. Note: This solution only available for dealers on the ADP support network, representing over 12,000 dealers.
- Provides dealer, upon request, information on who is accessing their system and how often, for each third party participating in the program
- Shuts off access to the DMS when requested by a dealer

ADP's VPN Access solution provides benefits to both dealers and third parties:

- Provides a reliable, consistent network solution, eliminating the need to build and maintain network connectivity to dealers one at a time
- Eliminates the need and cost of dial-up modems to access the DMS

For third parties that use the VPN Access product, ADP allows the use of the ADP Approved VPN Connection logo. Third parties may also use the tagline "PRODUCT connected through ADP approved VPN" where PRODUCT is the third party product name.
